Distribution of Free Printed Matter Designation Order No. 1 2009

NOTICE is hereby given that on 24 July 2009 the Borough Council of King's Lynn & West Norfolk, as principal litter authority, will make the Distribution of Free Printed Matter Designation Order No.1 2009 ("the Order") as detailed below in respect of the following areas of land in the area of the Borough Council of King's Lynn & West Norfolk pursuant to Section 94B of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 and paragraph 2(1) of Schedule 3A of the Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005. The effect of the Order will be to make it an offence for a person to distribute any free printed matter without the consent of the Borough Council of King's Lynn & West Norfolk on any relevant land. Relevant land is defined in Section 86(4) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 as land to which the public are entitled or permitted to have access with or without payment that is open to the air and under the direct control of the Borough Council of King's Lynn & West Norfolk, and any relevant highway within the area of the Borough Council of King's Lynn & West Norfolk as defined in Section 86(9) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 in the designated areas. The designated areas are listed in Schedules A, B, C and D below. Copies of the Order and maps are available for inspection for a period of 28 days [beginning with the date on which this notice is given] between the hours of 9.30am and 4.30pm at the Borough Council of King's Lynn & West Norfolk Offices at Kings Court, Chapel Lane, Kings Lynn, Norfolk, PE30 1EX, and The Priory Centre, Priory Road, Downham Market, Norfolk, PE38 9JT and Valentine Road, Hunstanton, Norfolk, PE36 5EF. Any persons wishing to make representations should make them in writing to Mr Jack Daniels at the Borough Council of King's Lynn & West Norfolk at Recycling and Waste Management, Central Depot, Hamlin Way, Kings Lynn, Norfolk, PE30 4NG to arrive not later than 12pm (noon) on 3 July 2009. **SCHEDULES OF DESIGNATED AREAS**

- A. Kings Lynn Town Centre within the area bounded by Boal Street, River Great Ouse, Purfleet Quay, King Street, St Nicholas Street, Chapel Street, Austin Street, Norfolk Street, Railway Road, St James' Road, Millfleet and Stonegate Street.
- B. Downham Market Town Centre within the area bounded by Priory Road, Paradise Road and High Street.
- C. Hunstanton Town Centre within the area bounded by South Promenade, Beach Terrace Road, The Green, Cliff Parade, Cliff Terrace, Northgate, Greevegate, Church Street, Westgate, Southend Road, Beach Terrace Road and Seagatepipe.
- D. The area of the promenade and the bathing beach at Hunstanton from its northern concreted extremity extending southwards to the northern side of the boat launching ramp adjacent to the sewer outlet pipe.

A person guilty of an offence under the Order is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 4 on the standard scale. Offenders will be issued with a fixed penalty notice in the amount of £75.

Application for consent and information on fee structures can be obtained by contacting the Borough Council. No distribution is allowed until consent has been granted.
